Beginning her ballet classes at Ballerina's School in Switzerland at the age of 5, Letizia discovers Jazz, Modern, Theatre Dance and Hip Hop through several workshops in Bienne and Neuchatel and other international dance workshops in Switzerland as well as by studying at Les Chaussons Dance School where she focused on the Luigi's Jazz Technique and Martha Graham Modern Dance Technique. Upon her dance graduation in Zurich she started performing as well as teaching Ballet, Jazz, and Hip Hop classes in several dance schools for adults and children.

As a performer Letizia toured around Switzerland, Italy, and other European countries before moving to Aruba in 2005 where she continued teaching ballet and jazz dance. There she developed a great passion for Salsa and after studying it with several teachers started performing with the Cuban troupe "Let's go Latin" at the Crystal Theater of Aruba.
